ONE YEAR AGO, we changed our name to LEAP: Learn. Engage. Advocate. Partner. Our new name continues to be reflected in our contributions to our community. I'm proud of our accomplishments this year including:

Learn: We increased enrollment in our Children's Center by 6% thanks to improved teacher training and retention.

Engage: More than 200 adults participated in one of our classes on parenting, immigration, financial literacy and advance care planning.

Advocate: We met with elected officials to advocate for child care and family support, and also discuss our Stop the Hate activities.

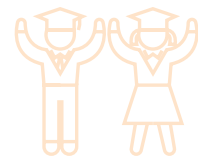

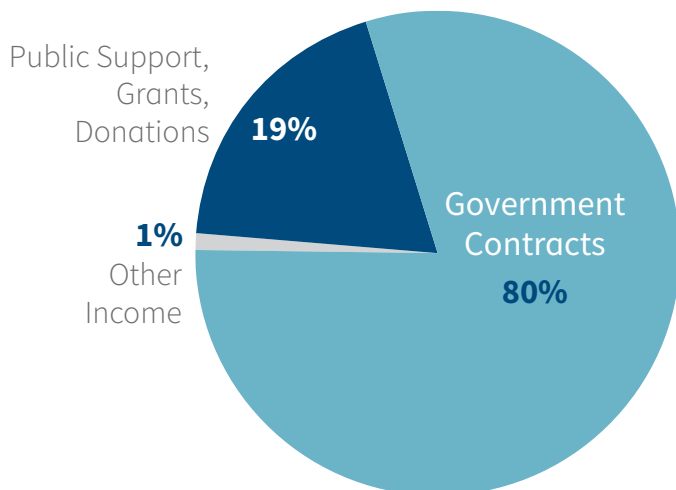

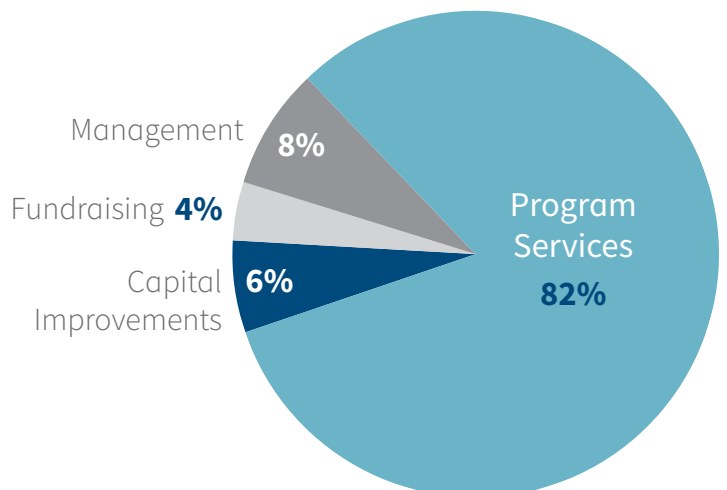
